



Doug Adkins – Artist Bio

The music of Montana born and raised, country singer-songwriter Doug Adkins reflects small-town life, working-class roots, and life growing up in the American Midwest. The songs are shaped by dirt roads, fence lines, county fairs, and all the life experiences and moments that don't make headlines, but quietly shape the people who live them.

Doug Adkins was raised in Northeastern Montana, where farm kids stayed home from school during harvest season to help on the family farm, and where daily life revolved around school activities, school sports, county fairs, and outdoor adventures under Montana skies! Those grounded, real-life experiences form the backbone of Doug's songwriting and again find their way into Doug Adkin's newest CD *"Don't Question Love."*

Real success came in 1995 with the release of "Whiskey Salesman," a self-autobiographical song about a bar singer, who felt his real job was to bring the party to the fans each night, selling whiskey for the bar owner, and hopefully being hired back. Twenty plus years of real stories like that have shaped Doug's songwriting. With 200+ original songs to his credit and 12 albums blending traditional values, honest story lines and life's experiences, Doug Adkin's craft as a songwriter and story teller shine through on the song of his latest release *"Don't Question Love."* A highlight of the album is track eight, *"Free."* Originally recorded in 1990 with the famed Buckaroos from Bakersfield California, it became the obvious **250th U.S.A. Anniversary-Birthday** choice, honoring those who sacrificed and served for our freedoms that we so easily enjoy!
