



Doug Adkins Delivers with “Don’t Question Love”

Growing up under Montana’s Big Sky, having life shaped by small towns, high school sports, long hot summer days outdoors, fishing, hunting and the sound of AM radio brings us the 12th CD from country artist Doug Adkins. Having written 200 country songs and counting, Adkins is hitting the high notes, highways and byways again to present his latest studio project, “Don’t Question Love.”

This is country music, played the way we love it, and expect it to be! In no time at all, you’ll find yourself tapping your toe and singing along to Doug’s upbeat, toe-tapping first single, *Don’t Question Love*, a snappy, feel-good country song about standing in line at the County Fair and falling in love on a Ferris wheel ride.

The album moves effortlessly between light-hearted country two-steps like *Left Hand Right* and *If You Will*, and powerful country ballads such as *Dinner for One* or *Feel the Same*. Before you realize, you’re being moved, touched by the vulnerability and honesty in the titles *I Don’t Drink Alone* as well as *The Old Cowboy In Me*, reminiscent of past classics like like *Poncho and Lefty*, stories complete! The southern-country rock anthem *Free* is written for America’s 250th birthday celebration this year 2026, while the rocking *Saints and Sinners* is a self-autobiographical look back at 25 years of writing and touring, and how he’d give anything to do it all again.

That’s what we used to expect from our country artists! Not 1-Hit Wonders, but those who have lived it and continue to make their livelihood doing just that... Hats off!
